It its therefore the Advice of this Board to his Excellency that he be pleased to issue a Commission appointing a Treasurer of the Western Shoar of this Province in the Room of Samuel Young Esq^r deceased

A Proclamation

Whereas His most sacred Majesty in Council bearing Date at S^t James's the twenty ninth Day of April Anno Domini 1736 hath ordered that in the Morning and Evening Prayers in the Litany, and in all Other Parts of the Publick Service as well in the Occasional Offices as in the Book of Common Prayer, where the Royal Family is appointed to be particularly prayed for the following Form and Order should be observed Viz. For His most sacred Majesty King George Our Gracious Queen Caroline, Their Royal Highnesses Frederick Prince of Wales, the Princess of Wales, the Duke, the Princesses and all the Royal Family: In pursuance of which Order I do publish
