As I have received Advice from the hoñble Col William Gooch, who is to have the Command of the Troops to be raised in America for his Majestys Service in the West Indies, p. 106 that he expects the Troops to be raised here should be put on board of the Transports at such a convenient Season, that he may depend upon their being at the Place of Rendezvous within the Capes of Virginia before the middle of September; Therefore that there may be no Disappointment in this particular, I have thought fit to give you this Notice, that you should provide Transports Victuals and other Necessaries to be ready at the Port & City of Annapolis in such convenient time, so as the said Troops be may be imbarked here and carryed to the Place of Rendezvous within the Capes of Virginia before the Middle of September
