We cannot but think it is absolutely necessary for the Welfare of the Province that small tight twelve foot houses or such as may be thought convenient be built in each County at or near the County Court Houses as Magazines wherein to p. 703 lodge the Arms & Ammunition of each respective County by which they may be frequently visitted & kept in better Repair at Small expence
