And forasmuch as the said Bill curtails the Jurisdiction of her Majesty's Courts we cannot think it safe for us at this Time to reenact such a Law but when a Governor in Chief comes fully instructed we shall readily join with you in representing to him what may be for the Benefit and Advantage of this Province
