Upon Receipt of your Message yesterday relating to the Arms and Ammunition and building Magazine Houses in each County this House took the same into Consideration and maturely debated the same and upon the Question put whether such Houses were necessary or convenient to be built or not? It past in the Negative. The House thereupon Resolved That the Arms and Ammunition remain in the Hands of the several Commanders in each County to whom the same hath been committed until the next Session of Assembly

This House have also ordered that M<sup>r</sup> Philemon Hemsley who intermarried with Col<sup>o</sup> Contee's Widow shall the next Session of Assembly lay before this House an Account of what Arms and Ammunition were lodged in Col<sup>o</sup> Contees Hands for the Use of the Public and how the same have been since disposed of.
