p. 711 added to the present Commission

Resolved and ordered that M^r Joshua Dorsey & M^r John Hammond be added thereto

The Petition of William Holmes and his Wife read and referred to the Justices of Prince George's County Court to proceed thereon according to Act of Assembly in ascertaining how long and to whom the Petitioners shall serve in Satisfaction to their fees

The Board adjourned until eight of the Clock to Morrow Morning
