We have received your Message of this Day by Col^o Hoskins and three others and cannot but once more express our Sentiments to you that since you have denied the Conference proposed in Order to inforce her Majesty's Royal Commands to this Province laid before you at the Beginning of this Session we must conclude that some of your House are possessed with a mistaken Zeal of the Interest of your Country which seems to have a great Influence on and mislead others wherefore we once more demand a Conference with the Members of your House upon the aforesaid subject Matter which if you shall contrary to the Course and Practice of Parliaments refuse us we shall be obliged to assert the Honour and Reputation of this Board by such proper Measures as we shall think most advisable
