M^r Roger Woolford & twelve more of the Delegates brought from their House a Bill for Limitation of Officers Fees Endorsed by their House

The Title of which being read It was ordered to lye on the Table

The Bill for relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggrievances in the prosecution of suits at Law being read at the Board, His Excellency is told that the Bill is not a new Bill but only revised at this Time And hath been transmitted some years since to her Majesty and the Lords Comm^{rs} of Trade & Plantations And nothing has ever been by the s^d Lords objected against it

The honble Philemon Lloyd Deputy Secretary desired to be heard thereto and offered that It was a prejudice to the Secretary's Office in restraining the Jurisdiction of the Provincial Court.

But the Bill intending a publick Good to the Inhabitants of this Province & not being prejudicial to any of her Majesty's Subjects in Great Brittain It having been first put to the Vote was Ordered to be thus Endorsed—
