Which being read his Excellency was pleased to say he was Satisfyed therewith and directed the Honble Col Lloyd and Col Holland to go to the House & acquaint them that his Excellency concurs with the s^d Message from the House of Delegates

The Petition of M^r Tho^s Reynolds of Ann Arundel County being read praying that upon the expiration of the Sherriffs Office of that County his Excellency would be pleased to grant him a Commission therefore

The s^d Petitioners Request upon the good Character of him given his Excellency by several Gentlemen of the Council is granted

The Board adjourned till Eight of the Clock to morrow morning.

July 3d

The Council in Assembly Sate Present as yesterday

The Petition of M^r Philip Lee being again taken into Consideration, Resolved the Petitioner pay Dutys for the Tobacco Shipped in this Province but that no Dutys ought to be paid for the Tob^o Shipped in Virginia and ordered that this Resolve be communicated to the respective Naval Officers in this Province
