 Dodd. And the same Members have a Message to signify  
 the said Appointm<sup>t</sup> to the Ho<sup>n</sup>ble Council.

They return and say they delivered the said Message.

Col<sup>o</sup> Holland and Philemon Lloyd Esq<sup>r</sup> enter the House  
 and deliver M<sup>r</sup> Speaker the ingrossed Bill for laying an Impo-  
 sition of 3<sup>d</sup> p Hhd. for defraying the Charge of the Province  
 with the following Indorsement Viz.

 Tilghman enter the House and acquaint M<sup>r</sup> Speaker that they
