In the Register of Prize Ships the Capture and Condemnation must be absolutely mentioned instead of the time and place of Building. List of all Ships trading to and from the Plantations or from one Plantation to another are to be prepared Quarterly by the Collectors of the Customs and the Naval Officers in the respective Plantations, in order to be transmitted by you to the Lord High Treasurer or Lords Commissioners of the Treasury for the time being, and to the Commissioners of his Majesty's Customs at London by the first Opportunity of Shipping every Quarter
