On reading and Considering the within Remonstrance We ^{p. 25} are of Opinion that there Can be no Reason for Exhibiting the same, for that the Justices of Dorchester County are not yet acquitted from facts last Assembly laid to their Charge by the Inhabitants of that County for the same matters Complained of by this Remonstrance as a Libelling of them which was then referred to yo^r Honours' Consideration.

But we must observe that if the member of our House Complained of hath Libelled the Justices of that County without Reason they may have their Remedy against him. However we hope if the facts alledged against the Justices be found True by your Honours, That the psons Exhibiting so Scandalous a Remonstrance may be punished according to their Deserts.
