Seventh Article we Agree that Two Years time be allowed to  
Absent psons. As to the Tenth Article we agree to Allow  
three months time from the End of this Sessions to those  
who have lost the Benefitt of their Review on the Act now  
in force and have Petitioned this Generall Assembly for  
Relief to be Determined in the same manner as that Act  
Directs and desire your Exc<sup>v</sup> and Honours Concurrence with  
the Amendments in the Report of the Conferences and this  
Message Mentioned.
