On reading the bill for the Limitation of Officers ffees his Excy is Pleased to Observe that my Lord Baltemore Designs to Come to his Government here And his Excy not having any Particular Instruction from his Lordship relating to such an Act which makes so Vast an Alteration in the sev^l Great Offices of this Province Desires that nothing may be Done therein But that the Act as It now stands may be Revived till the 29th of Sept^r 1720 his L^dship then Being of Age To which this house Agrees
