tives We find that the Paragraph therein which makes a Pro-
vision for Widows Excludes all Relations after Bro^{rs} and
Sisters Children from Inheriting any Part of the Intestates p. 86
Estate which we think unreasonable & Contrary To the Act
of Assembly Provided for the Better Adm^{con} of Justice in
Testamentary Affairs. It is therefore thought necessary that
that Paragraph in this Act should be made agreeable to that
Act which is Agreeable to the Laws of England with which
Amendments it will Pass
