on these little Animalls has Cost the Country by a Modest L. H. J. computation in one year 7000^{ls} Sterling.

When I reflect on the happy increase of the Youth in this Province, and the vast Importation of Europeans and Negroes into it Yet that the Number of your Taxables, do not Amount to what it might be reasonably expected from these causes It is Natural from hence to conclude th' there are not Just returns made to the publick this is worthy your Inquisition, and in my Opinion there Cannot be too Severe penaltys imposed on such who willfully conceal their Taxables, and So defraud the publick; Whereas all that receive protection from your Laws, ought to bear equal proportion of that Charge which is Levy'd for the Common good.
