On a second reading the bill for the better Supporting the Magistrates in the Administration of Justice within this Province this house proposes the following Amendments to be made at the Severall marks therein viz:

1. Ministeriall officers or other persons.
2. Suspending such practitioners of the law from their practice perpetually or for a time or to punish such practitioners or Ministeriall officers or other persons.
3. Not exceeding four thousand pounds of Tobacco in the Superior Courts nor two thousand pounds of Tobacco in the Severall County Courts within this Province on each offender for any one offence.

With which if your house Concurrs the bill will pass.
