L. H. J. Resolved it pass as it now is. Thereupon the bill will pass which was so Endorst and sent to the Upper House by M^r [Tyler] and Cap^t Frisby

They return and say they delivered it.

Ordered the Committee of Laws prepare a bill against buying Selling farming or giveing or takeing of Gratuitys for offices.

Ordered that the Committee of aggrievances inspect the Act for limitation of officers fees and make their report thereon to the house and ordered that Cap^t Codd Coll: Maxwell M^t Walter Smith Maj^t Emerson [&] Cap^t Colegate be added to the Committee.

The Bill to prevent the Cutting of Intailes within this province was read the first time and Ordered a second reading to Morrow.

The house adjourns till to Morrow Morning eight a Clock

Fryday Morning May the 29th 1719

And sent to the Upper House by M' Hill M' Caldwell Major Phillips and M' Wailes.

They return and say they delivered them.
