all projects of your Enemies and to Establish a Protestant
constitution in Church and State in all your Dominions

May the bounty of Heaven continue your Majesty and your
Posterity to be the Arbiters of Europe, the terror of your
Enemies, and the Joy of your people till time shall be no more. p. 145
