They further find that there hath been remitted from England blank Bills amounting in the Whole to £89987..10^{sh}..0 that the Bills remitted are such as the Act of Assembly for emitting the mony directs, and that there only wants to make up the Sum of ninety thousand pounds ten twenty Shilling Bills & ten five Shilling Bills

Your Committee further find that the Account hereunto annexed is a just & true Account of the money emitted & remaining in the said Office & humbly Submitt the same to both Houses of Assembly
