 morning. M^r Smith Col Hooper Col Belt and Col Hanson Ap-
 pointed a Committy to Enquire into the State and Condition of the
 Arms and Ammunition, and the accounts relateing thereto and to
 make their Report.

 of both Houses be taken into Consideration on the morrow
