George Plater Esq^r from the Upper House Delivered to M^r Speaker the Journal of the Committee of Accounts Indorsed. Read and Assented to; Provided there be an Allowance made to John Young for his Account therewith Sent.

A Bill Entituled an Act Impowering a Committee to lay Assess and Apportion the Publick Levy for this Present Year One thousand seven hundred and thirty three, was read the first and Second time; by Especial Order and passed.

Ordered that M^r Lewis be Allowed at the Laying the Levy, Forty Shillings, And M^r Clark, M^r Ghislin, and M^r Gough thirty Shillings Each for Extraordinary Services done this Assembly.
