

Liber yo^r Pet^r humbly conceaves in Equity still liable to the Attatchm^t,
 P. C. R. granted by Cap^t Stone, all Justice being impeded from th^t time, untill
 yo^r Pet^r proceeded agst Job Chandler for the s^d Estate, In tender
 Consideraõn of all w^{ch} premises yo^r Pet^r humbly prayeth That the s^d
 parties may according to the usuall Cours in Chancery putt in their
 answere uppon Oath, & declare why the s^d Estate was soe protected as
 afores^d, & after wth out any notice gyuen to your Pet^r, or his
 Attorney, or any Legall proceeding for recalling of the obligaõn
 past as afores^d for securing the s^d Estate, Deliuered up & p^emitted
 to be exported. And uppon what tearmes, or security the same was
 done & permitted. As also who hyred or borrowed the s^d Sloope
 for the exportaõn, And if hyred whither by the month or the
 Voyage, And what men were in her to sayle her, how called, & how
 & by whom payed & uictualled. What was the hyre of the Sloope,
 where & by whom payd, & in what Co^modity? By w^{ch} yo^r Pet^e
 p. 145 doubts not but yo^u will find sufficient cause to relieue him, And th^t
 untill this suite be determined, the Sheriffe may be Ordered to take
 into his possesⁿ the negroes, th^t were formerly part of the Estate
 attached, now in the possesⁿ of the s^d Chandler & Ouerzee: or they
 Ordered to be responsable for them when the s^d suite is ended.

Barton v. Gerard Command Thomas Gerrard Esq^r & Susan his Wife to hould plea,
 to William Barton; of Barton Hall Mariner in an accõn of Couent
 to him the s^d Will^m Bartin of Three hund^d Acres of Land, one
 dwelling howse One Orchard, Two Tobaccho howses Lying or being
 in the Manno^e of S^t Clem^{ts} in the County of S^t Maries, according to
 a Couent or Deed of Bargaine & Sale from the s^d Thomas Gerard,
 to the s^d Will^m Barton Bearing date the Twentieth day of Septemb^r
 Año Dñi 1658, and is as followeth. Josias ffendall.

This Indenture made the Twentieth day of Septemb^r in the yeare
 of Our Lord God One Thowsand six hund^d fifty & Eight, Betweene
 Thomas Gerard of S^t Clem^{ts} manno^r Esq^r of the one part, And Will^m
 Barton of Barton Hall Mariner of the other part, Wittnesseth That
 the sayd Thomas Gerard hath for a ualuable Consideraõn Bargayned
 & sold, And by these p^ents doth bargaine & sell unto the s^d Will^m
 Barton One neck & parcell of Land Bownded wth a marked white
 Oake, Standing from the head of the back Creek of Canow neck One
 hund^d & Sixteene perches running East to the head of the s^d Creek
 of Canow neck by the neck East Sowth East into S^t Clem^{ts} Bay for
 the length of One hund^d & Twenty perches or thereabouts And on
 the East wth the s^d Bay of S^t Clem^{ts} for the length of One hund^d &
