M^r Edward Packer sworne in open Court sayth th^t sometime in June was Twelfmonth being aboard Cap^t Tilghmans ship, he heard the difference discussed betwixt the p^{if} & the d^{eft} concerning this hogshead of Tob: yett after much dispute & contention betwixt them, both parties were satisfied (as this Depon^t understood & imagined) And thereuppon Rob^t Kedger signed a Bill of Exchange of ffowre pownd sterl, to the p^{if}.

It clearely appearing to the Court both by Rob^t Morris his attestaon Date of the Protest & Lr^e of Exchange, & M^r Packers Deposⁿ that th^t hogshead in dispute was not shipped by the d^{eft} to the intent to satisfy this Bond, as the d^{eft} seemes to inferre: neyther had the p^{if} any p^ticular Care or Charge gyuen, & undertooke by him, in or concerning the same It is therefore Ordered that the D^{eft} pay his Debt of ffowre pownds sterl to the p^{if}, wth Twenty shillings ouer & aboue for dammage, and ffowre shillings more for the Protest, Besides Costs of suite.

Know all men by these p^{nts} th^t I Will^m Edwin of the Prouince of Maryland doe bind my selfe my heyres Executo^{rs} & Admⁿistrato^{rs} to pay or cause to be payd unto Cap^t Samuel Tilghman or his appoyntm^t, for the use of the Owners of the ship Goulden ffortune the summe of Twelue hund^d pownds of good soun^d bright & large Tob in cask, w^{ch} is for my passage in the s^d ship from England to Maryland, wth in three weeks after the s^d ships arryuall there. And in Case of Default thereof, th^t then I the s^d Will^m Edwin doe bind my selfe, my heyres, Executo^{rs} & Admⁿistrato^{rs} firmly by these p^{nts} to deliuer & make ouer unto the s^d Cap^t Tilghman for the use afores^d Two good Milch Cowes under the age of fvue yeares, & not to be lesse then Three yeares old apeece & I the s^d William doe further binde my selfe & c th^t if in Case one halfe of the s^d Tob be not payd by the time afores^d that then to deliuer unto the s^d Cap^t One Cow of the Condi^{co}ns before mentioned, wittnes my hand & Seale this 10th of January 1656
