As to the Indian Slaue I Job Chandler of Portoback in the prouince of Maryland do hereby testify, th^t Leiuten^t Will^m Lewis of the same place for a ualuable Consideraōn in hand receiued, was indebted by Bill unto my Brother Symon Ouerzee an Indian Slaue. Vnto the w^{ch} Bill I the s^d Chandler was a wittnes, & had the s^d Bill sometime in my possesⁿ to demand the s^d Indian Slaue. And further I doe testify, th^t the s^d Slaue was neuer deliuered or received: & th^t I know not of any other satisfaction giueⁿ for the s^d Slaue. The s^d Bill was dated the 2^d of Nouemb^r 1653. Wittnes my hand this 23th of August 1658.

Moreou^c I the s^d Job Chandler doe further testify th^t I had the s^d Bill of Leiuten^t Will^m Lewis in my possesⁿ after his death, wth another Bill for Corne & Tob due from the s^d Lewis, & then deliuered them both unto my Brother Ouerzee againe, as wittness my hand 23 August 1658.

And to be payd proportionably out of the Land to be extended of the s^d Cap^t Lewis att Nangemy.
