went up & downe complayning for want of prouision & uictuals,
yett the Gou^r being satisfyed in th^t, the s^d Harbert had sufficient
prouisions in his Sloop & gaue sufficient allowance to the Passengers,
as hee alleageth. Hee is dismissed.

Hampstead The humble Petⁿ of Will^m Hampsted Sheweth That whereas M^r
v. Overzee Symon Ouerzee standeth indebted to yo^r Pet^r one Cow & a Calfe, w^{ch}
p. 197 should haue bene deliuered to him uppon his Plantaōn att S^t Maries
5 yeares agoe, & are not yett payd, being much damnifyed in the
losse of their encrease, & the want of the milk for his sustenance,
W^{ch} Cattle he hath often demanded of M^r Ouerzee, But hee hath not
yett taken any Course to satisfy the same, allso yo^r Pet^r sheweth th^t
M^r Ouerzee standeth indebted to him 100^t Tob for a barrell of Corne
bought of M^r Land for the s^d M^r Ouerzees use, for w^{ch} he craueth
order, & allsoe dammage for his encrease of his Cattle & want of the
milk &c:

The dēft requesteth th^t the p^{lf} proue what is alleaged in his Petⁿ.

Adam Christian aged 28 yeares or thereabouts sworne & exam-
ined this 20th January 1658 Sayth That during his time of Seruice
wth M^r Ouerzee, Will^m Hampstead demanded of the s^d Ouerzee
Cattle due from him to the s^d Hampsted & M^r Ouerzee promised the
s^d Hampsted to deliuer him his Cattle here att S^t Maries, soe soone
as his Sloop came up againe from Virginia & further Sayth not.

Thomas Kemp Examined att the request of William Hampsted
this 7th day of ffebruary 1658 Sayth, That att Linne Hauen in
Virginia there was a Cow & a Cow calfe made choyce of for M^r
Hampsteds use by M^r Richardson, W^{ch} Cow is since dead. Yett
before th^t shee dyed, shee had another Cow calfe w^{ch} calfe M^r Ouer-
zee marked, but what is since become of th^t calfe, he cannot tell.
