in th^t Case prouided, And agst the peace of the Lord Prop^r his
Rule & Gouverm^t.

the ffact in the fellonious contryuing & Counselling the s^d marriage,
& allso in ioyning the s^d parties in marriage, after hee had diuorced
the s^d Robert Holt & Dorothy his Wife agst the peace of his L^p his
Rule & Gouverm^t as afores^d. After the Presentm^t was read, The
Prisoners alleage th^t this Jury is a uery weake Jury, to goe uppon soe
weighty a busines, (they being soe nearely concernd therein) as life
& death, And there being few others p^ent in Court but what are
Catholikes, w^{ch} The prisoners afore requested might not be warned
on their Jury, desyring that a Protestant Jury might passe on them,
& w^{ch} the Gouverno^e consented unto, as most reasonable.

It is Ordered th^t the Sheriffe take sufficient Bayle of Rob^t Holt for
his appearance att the next Prouinciall Court, And the Gou^ernor^f
himsel^fe assumed to bee M^r W^m Wilkinson's Bayle

Overzee v.
Cornwaleys

To the hon^{bte} the Gouverno^e & Councill &c:

The humble Petⁿ of Symon Ouerzee Sheweth Whereas Cap^t
Thomas Cornwaleys is indebted to yo^e Pet^e 3370^t Tob & Cask for
goods deliuered by his Store-keeper uppon a note of Credit sent
by the s^d Cap^t dat, Decembr^r 5th 1657, yo^e Pet^e therfore humbly
prayeth an order for the s^d Debt, & damages susteyned for want of
the Tob to compleate his freight, wth charges of suite. And he shall
pray &c:

To w^{ch} demand & Petⁿ of the p^{tf}, The dēft sayth, th^t he sent his
Vid. fol. noate (uppon request) for certaine goods mentioned in his noate, &
230 to a certaine summe, And how th^t the Debt ought to haue been de-
manded of the party to whom the s^d goods were deliuered. And th^t
hee assumed to pay soe far, as his noate of Credit extended, & is not
obliged to pay further.

This Cause is putt a Jury war^t to the Sheriffe for Jury.
