Know all men by these p^ents th^t I Will^m Mitchell haue constituted authorized & appoynted Cap^t Will^m Stone my true & lawfull Attorney to arrest impleade & prosecute Will^m Boareman Plant^r for a Debt from him to mee due by specialty. And to impower constitute, ordaine & make one or more Attorney or Attorneys if hee shall thinke fitt, hereby ratifying & confirming whatsoever my s^d Attorney shall doe in the premises as fully to all intents & purposes, as if the same had bene done by my selfe. Whereas it appeareth to this Court th^t Will^m Boareman dēft is indebted to Cap^t Will^m Mitchell by Bill Two Thowsand one hund^d & Sixty pownds Tob & cask payable uppon demand, The s^d Bill bearing date 13th of Octob^r 1656. And whereas Cap^t Will^m Stone by uertue of a lrē of Attorney from the s^d Mitchell hath sued the s^d Boreman for the whole debt, The s^d Boareman produced this Receipt for Eight hund^d & fifty pownds of Tob allready satisfied of th^t Debt. Receaued of Will^m Boareman the summe of six hund^d pownds of Tob & cask, in part of a Bill now in Cap^t Will^m Stones hand from the fores^d Boareman to Cap^t Will^m Mitchell & one hogge att the price of Two hund^d & fifty pownds of Tob.

The pff, by his Petⁿ demandeth Order for 1000^l Tob agst the dēft, attached in the hands of Thomas Mitchell There being much more due unto him by sundry specialties under the dēfts hand, then what is here attached.
