Whereas att the last Prouinciall Court held att S^t Maries 3^d of March last, The p^{tf} then Petitioned & requested to be possessed wth a Seru^t, belonging to the dēft, on the behalfe of her Children, & under attatchm^t, for a Debt due unto the s^d Children from the dēft, as appeares uppon the Records of this Prouince And whereas by th^t Order afores^d the Attatchm^t was continued, & the Pet^r Ordered to bring Certificate to this Court th^t the deft had notice gyuen him of the s^d Attatchm^t, W^{ch} the p^{tf} is not able to declare or say that hee had. Yett the Board being certifiyed th^t some Inhab^{ts} here, had desyred certaine liuers, neare Neighbo^{es} to the dēft, to certify him thereof, to the end he might haue notice, & giue his attendance att this Court, if hee should see cause therefore. Who not appearing eyther by himselfe or Attorney.

It is therefore Ordered, th^t the p^{tf} shall haue the seruant soe attached putt into her Custody; & him to keepe till the last day of Nouember next, Vnlesse the dēft come afore th^t time, & make prooffe th^t the p^{tf} hath iniured him in her fores^d demand. And if he appeares not afore or att the s^d prefixed time, then the p^{tf} to haue Judgment, uppon default, for the residue of the s^d seruants time, And ffrurther th^t the p^{tf} use all ordinary dilligence to giue the dēft notice of this Order.

The humble Petⁿ of Joseph Wicks, Sheweth That in ffebruary in the yeare (55) yo^r Pet^r agreed wth M^r Richard Owens for a mayd seruant, ffor w^{ch} yo^r Pet^r was to pay unto the s^d Owens Two thousand Three hund^d pounnds of good Tob in Cask, W^{ch} paym^t was well & truly performed unto the s^d Owens by yo^r Pet^r, ffor w^{ch} fores^d summe of Tob, the s^d Owens ingaged himselfe unto yo^r Pet^r to deliuer
