And whereas att a Prouinciall Court held for this Prouince in
 Caluert County on the 8th day of Octobr last the s^d Thomas Sowth Vid. fol. 125
 Petitioned for a rehearing, touching the Costs & dammages only :
 for th^t the Commis^{rs} of the County of Kent afores^d intermedled wth a
 Cause not wth in their Cognizance, w^{ch} was then graunted (as by the
 s^d Order & Petⁿ 8^o Octobr may more fully appeare) And whereas
 likewise att the Prouinciall Court held att S^t Maries the 3^d of March Vid. fol. 214
 last a Easpeciall writt or Commisⁿ was directed to Coth Nathaniel Vtie
 & Edward Lloyd Esq^r, Joseph Wicks & Cap^t Rob^t Vaughan genⁿ.
 The wittnesses touching the fores^d Dammages & Costs dilligently to
 examine & the Examinaōns into this Prouinciall Court, distinctly &
 clearely to send, Together wth their Opinions, what uppon the prem-
 ises is fitt to bee done, (as by the s^d Order & Writt may allso ap-
 peare) make returne thereof as followeth (Viz)

To the hon^{bte} the Gour & Councell

Whereas a Commisⁿ (bearing date the 3^d of March 1658) was
 directed to Vs from yo^r honou^{rs} to heare matters of difference
 betweene John Salter p^{tf} & Thomas Sowth & Thomas Hinson dēfts,
 & hauing dilligently examined the premises doe humbly make Our
 Report as followeth, ffirst as Touching the da^mages alleaged by the
 s^d John Salter agst the afores^d Thomas Sowth. Wee apprehend the
 s^d Sowth is not lyable to satisfy any da^mages uppon former accounts ;
 by reason the s^d Sowth held his possesⁿ by Order of Law, W^{ch} s^d
 Order wee haue hereunto annexed.

Concerning the Charge of building & clearing alleaged by the
 defend^{ts}, We thinke it may bee ballanced by da^mage done unto the
 Plantaōn.

As for all other differences (brought before us) depending be-
 tweene the s^d parties or eyther of them, They did willingly com-
 pose betwixt themselues
