

Liber Land from his s^d Brother. The s^d M^r Henry Coursey alleaging, th^t
P. C. R. it is allready Surueyed for him. And humbly Craueth th^t M^r Wil-
 liam Coursey may declare & informe the Court whither or noe hee
 did understand th^t the Pet^r had marked th^t Land there. And whither
 hee hath surueyed that Land for his Brother, now in dispute, yea or
 noe?

Will^m Coursey, Sayth uppon Oath, That goeing to suruey Land on
 the Easterne shoare, he found a Tree marked there wth an (H) &
 understood by M^r Ringould th^t M^r Hinson had marked some trees
 in th^t place: But knew not in what Branch hee had marked them; for
 in the Creeke there were Two branches. And that hee hath not
 surueyed th^t Land for his Brother Henry, or any other, now claymed
 by M^r Hinson.

Ordered therefore th^t the Surueyo^r Suruey that Land specified
 and marked by M^r Hinson, for the s^d Hinsons use.

Kent It is Ordered that those Plantaōns already seated, or to bee seated
County on the Easterne shoare adioyning & neare to the Isle of Kent, shall
Limits bee esteemed as belonging to Kent County, till further Order therein
 from the Gou^r & Councell to the Contrary.

Attorney Was called afore the Board Thomas Thurstone & demanded why

Thurston hither againe contrary to an Order sett forth & published on the 23th
Vide 3 Md. day of July last, in contempts of his L^{ps} authority here. Deluding
Arch. Coun. the poeple wth uisions & such like fancies uery preiudiciall to his L^{ps}
364 peace & gouerm^t, & noe small disturbance to the quiett of the whole
 prouince.

In answeere thereto the s^d Thomas Thurstone Sayth That hee hath
 not bene in the prouince aboue Twelue dayes & therefore doth not
 conceaue th^t That Order hath relaōn to him being in the prouince att
 the making & publishing thereof. That hee hath not done any thing,
 since his arryuall, preiudiciall to the peace of his L^p, or quiett of the
 Prouince: Neyther doth hee conceaue that hee hath bene formerly
 banished.

Whereuppon the Court Ordered this following Order to be drawne
 up and published. [See 3 Md. Arch. Coun. 364]

The Gouerno^r dissolved the Court.
