The Condi<sup>o</sup>n of this Obliga<sup>o</sup>n is such That if the aboue bownd John Wade his Executo<sup>rs</sup>, Adm<sup>i</sup>strato<sup>rs</sup> or Assignes doe truly pay to the aboue named Thomas Ticknor his Executo<sup>rs</sup>, Adm<sup>i</sup>strato<sup>rs</sup> or Assignes att or in the now dwelling howse of the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Ticknor, scituate in Bishshops gate streete London, The so<sup>m</sup>e of ffifty & Three pounnds of lawfull money of England (being for goods & merchandizes receiued of the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Ticknor by the s<sup>d</sup> John Wade for the use of his Planta<sup>o</sup>n in Maryland aboue mentioned) in & uppon the Twelcluth day of Aprill next comcing after the date aboue written That then this Obliga<sup>o</sup>n to bee uoyde, or ells to stand in full force & Vertue, John Wade, Sealed & deliuered in the p<sup>e</sup>sence of us W<sup>m</sup> Salisbury Ser<sup>r</sup> Rob<sup>r</sup> Pryme

The p<sup>if</sup> produceth the Copie of a Bond signed by John Wade Chyrurgeon deceased bearing date 12<sup>o</sup> Octob<sup>r</sup> 1658, Wherein the s<sup>d</sup> Wade is bownd to the p<sup>if</sup> under the penalty of one hund<sup>d</sup> pounnds for the paym<sup>t</sup> of ffifty three pounnds Sterl, as is conteyned in the s<sup>d</sup> Bond.

The Adm<sup>i</sup>strato<sup>r</sup> not prouing th<sup>t</sup> any thing was eyther payd by the s<sup>d</sup> Wade, or himselfe in Satisfaction of this Debt, & not able to obiect any thing concerning the Bond, & the iustness thereof, It is Ordered th<sup>t</sup> the p<sup>if</sup> haue Judgm<sup>t</sup> agst the Adm<sup>i</sup>strato<sup>r</sup> for ffifty Three pounnds sterl. according to the s<sup>d</sup> Bond.
