Bee it knowne unto all men by these p<sup>nts</sup> That I Owen James of the Prouince of Maryland under the gouern<sup>t</sup> of the L<sup>d</sup> Baltmore Planter, doe hereby acknowledge & confesse th<sup>t</sup> I doe owe & am indebted unto Thomas Ticknor Cittizen & Grocer of London, the so<sup>me</sup> of ffifty fower pownds, one shilling, & Two pence of Lawfull money of England for diuers goods, waires & commodities by mee receaued & had of the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Ticknor, for the supplying of my planta<sup>o</sup>ns in the Prouince of Maryland afores<sup>d</sup>, And to be payd unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Ticknor his heyres, Adm<sup>rs</sup>, or Assignes uppon the Tenth day of March next ensuing the date hereof. And for the true paym<sup>t</sup> thereof unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Ticknor his Executo<sup>rs</sup> & Assignes. I bind mee my heyres Executo<sup>rs</sup> & Adm<sup>strato</sup>rs in the su<sup>me</sup> of One hund<sup>d</sup> & Eight pownds of lawfull money of England, firmly by these p<sup>nts</sup>. Sealed w<sup>th</sup> my Seale dated the Seauenteenth day of Nouemb<sup>r</sup> in the yeare of Our Lord God, One Thowsand six hund<sup>d</sup> ffifty & fflower. The marke of the s<sup>d</sup> Owen James Signed, Sealed & Deliuered in the p<sup>nce</sup> of John Steuens, Thomas Pearson Ser<sup>r</sup>.

To all poeple to whom this p<sup>nt</sup> writing shall come, I Owen James of the Prouince of Maryland, under the Gouvern<sup>t</sup> of the L<sup>d</sup> Baltmore Planter & now bownd out from the Port of London to the Prouince afores<sup>d</sup> send Greeting. Whereas I the s<sup>d</sup> Owen James in & by a certaine Bill or writing under my hand & Seale bearing date the day  
p. 359 of these presents stand indebted & bownd to pay unto Thomas Ticknor Cittizen & Grocer of London in the su<sup>me</sup> of ffifty fowre pownds, One shilling & Two pence payable uppon the Tenth day of March next ensuing the date of the s<sup>d</sup> Bill. And for true p<sup>e</sup>formance thereof, being for goods, wares, commodities & merchandizes by me receaued & had of the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Ticknor for the supply of my Planta<sup>o</sup>ns in the Prouince afores<sup>d</sup> I haue bownd my selfe in Executors & Adm<sup>strato</sup>rs in the summe of one hund<sup>d</sup> & Eight pownds as by the s<sup>d</sup> Bill of Debt or writing (relation being thereunto had) may att large appeare. And whereas allso I the s<sup>d</sup> Owen James haue laden & intend to lade aboard the good Ship called the Goulden ffortune of London, whereof Samuel Tilghman is master under God, now bound out uppon a Voyage to the Prouince of Maryland diuers goods merchandizes & commodities, the p<sup>r</sup>ticulars whereof are mentioned & expressed in an Inuoyce thereof hereunto annexed, & are to goe under the marke in the margent. Now know Yee th<sup>t</sup> I the s<sup>d</sup> Owen James for & in Considera<sup>o</sup>n of the better security of true paym<sup>t</sup> & satisfaction to bee made unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Ticknor his Executo<sup>rs</sup> or Assignes of the su<sup>me</sup> of ffifty fflower pownds, One shilling, & Two pence according to the teno<sup>r</sup> of the s<sup>d</sup> Bill of Debt Haue bargayned & sould & by these p<sup>nts</sup> doe bargaine & sell unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Ticknor his Executo<sup>rs</sup>, Adm<sup>strato</sup>rs & Assignes to his & their owne use & uses, All & Euery the s<sup>d</sup> goods, merchandizes & commodities in the s<sup>d</sup>
