Dauid Lett me desire yo^u to pay vnto Cap^t Guyther five hund^d pounds of tobacco which debt is due for hoggs yo^u bought of me and in soe doing this my noate with his Receipt shall be yo^r discharge as Wittnes my hand this 17th of October 1659

The def^t acknowledges Judgem^t to the plt in the Sume of sixteene hundred pounds of tobacco and Caske by bill dated the 23th of February 1659 payable the tenth of November following and the dēfd^t to pay costs of Suite.

Abercrombie Articles of Agreem^t made this Eight day of December 1660 Be-
v. Carver tweene William Caruer of Elizabeth Riuer in the County of Lower Norff in Virg^a of the one party and Dauid Abercromy Master and Owner of the Barque Speedwell the other party as followeth

I the aforesaid William Caruer doth hereby agree promise and Couenante with the aforesaid Dauid Abercromy wynd and weather permitting, and the danger of the Seas excepted to be in S^t Marys in the Province of Maryland with my Kitch calld' the Fortune, betweene the first and the last day of February next ensuing the date hereof then and there to receiue such and soe many hogsheads
