To the honorable Gouvernor and Councill of the Prouince of Mary-land Re Bushell's Estate

The humble peticoⁿ of William Bushell Sheweth That yo^r peticoⁿ being the Right heire apparant vnto Thomas Bushell his brother deceased ought by the lawe to haue a Co^m^{on} of Administracoⁿ granted vnto him of the personall Estate of his said Brother deceased and also with such lands as he was seized of at the tyme of his decease

Wherefore yo^r peticoⁿ humbly craueth that he may haue Ad^{con} of the said Estate as vnto the Right heire belongeth and that all such persons as shall in any injust waye contrary both to Lawe and Equity deteyne and withould any p^{te} or parcell of the said Estate and yo^r poore pet^r being able soe to prove by powerfull Evidence Humbly implores through yo^r Justice by granting a Co^m^{on} that all such either person or p^{sons} whoe shall or may be called vpon in this case and refuseth to Surrender may be compelled vpon oathe And yo^r pet^r shall pray &c.

the p^t as Brother to Thomas Bushell deceased demands the Estate of inherritance of Thomas Bushell de^{cd}, And further desires that he may haue Ad^{con} vpon the said Estate to which the def^t replied not But desired that it might be referred to the next Courte and th^t in the meane tyme the de^f^t haue a Coppy of the p^ts peticoⁿ William Bushell v. Thomas Dent

It is ordered that the Sherriffe take into his Custody John dawson and Thomas Coartney Attorney General v. Dawson & Courtney
