Evans v. Clodoueus Mace aged 30 yeares & upwards, att the Request of
Girard Cap^t Will^m Euans Deposd this 10th August 1657^o Sayth as ffollow-

such time, as he lyued wth the s^d M^r Bretton (as he . . . 7 or 8 yeares

Norman marked, att M^r Brettons Landing, to th^t intent, & for his
s^d Daughter, W^{ch} Calfe after a yeare or two growing, had a Calfe
att M^r Brettons, Afterwards leauing th^t his plantaōn att M^r Brettons
he carryed th^t Cow, & her encrease, to the head of the Bay S^t
Clements. Afterwards againe he remoued to Longworths Poynt, in
