Attorney General v. Cæcilius Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of
Claiborne Maryland and Avalon Lord Barron of Baltemore &c. To the Sherriff of Calvert County Greeting Whereas W^m Cleybourne heretofore of the Ile of Kent stands attainted by Act of Generall Assembly of this Province dated 24th of March 1637 for Pyracy and murther whereby his whole Estate both Reall & personall became forfeited then vnto vs, And Whereas the s^d W^m Cleybourne & his Complices haue since the s^d Attaynder Comitted many Outrages and open Acts of Hostility by which we are dampnified att the leaste the vullue of 2000th sterl: and for which haueing fledd from Justice he stands by Publick Act of the Generall Assembly of this Province Exempted from Pardon, And whereas wee are informed that the s^d W^m Cleybourne hath of late Acquired some Estate within this Province whereby he may be attached Theis are therefore to will and require yoⁿ forthwith vpon Sight hereof to attache any the Estate Reall or personall of W^m Cleybourne aforesaid, and att the same tyme to Cite or Suñon Publicly the s^d W^m Cleybourne to appeare att the next Pro^{all} Co^{rt} to be held at S^t Marys on the first Tewsdays in October next there to answer to such Trespasses, wasts, misdemeano^{rs} Contempts and seditious practices As our Attorney shall haue to Charge him with on our behalfe & then & there returne this writt Giuen at S^t Marys this 7th August 1662. Wittnes our deare Brother Philip Caluert Esq^r our deputy Leivtenn^t of our s^d Province
