The p^rmisses Considered yo^r pet^r humbly prayes that the said Bradshawe may by this Hono^{ble} be Compelled to take yo^r pet^r into his owne Service againe; or else to sell yo^r pet^r to such person as yo^r pet^r shall make Choyce of And he shall pray &c.

The def^t pleades that he did not sell him but with his Consent as may be proved by the Oath of Cap^t W^m Boarman and Cap^t Boarman takeing his oathe in open Co^{rt} that he did not buy him ag^t his Consent. It is Ordered that he serue Cap^t Boarman till the tyme accustomed for Servants be expired.
