The humble peti^cōn of John Hammond Sheweth That the last Spring yo^r pet^r bought of John Lumbroso certaine Goods for a Sum^e of tobacco by them agreed on payable att the Cropp who offered him Bill for the same which he delayed to take, he professing very much kindnes & severall extraordinary Curtesyes to him yo^r pet^r but by his frequenting yo^r pet^{rs} howse, and by some discourse dropt from his wife and the s^d Lumbroso, he found cause to forwarne him his howse, The s^d Lumbroso being soe debarred of his former admittance sends one Isham to demand bill of yo^r pet^r for a greater Quantity then was due to him which yo^r pet^r refused to pass, he the s^d Lumbroso reported that he had intrusted yo^r pet^r with his Goods and Could not gett payment, But that yo^r pet^r would haue had him layn with his wife for satisfaccōn and broached the same soe Confidently and frequently that itt became a Generall discourse and hath soe blemisht yo^r pet^r that he is become the by word and Scoff of many and hath soe irrepayrable injured him both in this Province and Virginea that itt hath woly taken away his hope of Liuely hood, He therefore prayeth that the matter & aggrevacōns may be seriously taken notice of and he repayred according to the merritt of his Offence and yo^r pet^{rs} suffrings And he shall pray &c.

Walter Pakes aged fifty foure yeares sworne and Examined in open Co^{rt} sayth, That sometyme the last Spring being att the howse of M^r Sheirtcliffe, he this depon^t did heare att the howse that Doctor Lumbroso should say that M^r Hammond had proffered him his wife to lye wth her in satisfaccōn of some Goods the said Hammond had of the said Lumbroso, And this depon^t goeing home to his howse mett with M^r Hamōnd where this did reprove the s^d Hamōnd for proffering his wife to the s^d Lumbroso whereupon M^r Hammond answered this depon^t that he asked the s^d Lumbroso why he gaue his wife an Elle of fine Holland and the said Lumbroso answered him, that he gave itt her for the tymes he had layne with her, And the s^d Hamōnd swore many Bloody oathes and called the s^d Lumbroso
