Lawson v. Whereas John Lawson pff att a Court held att Patux^t 24^o Aprill
Goodrick 1655 made appeare th^t Leiuten^t Will^m Lewis was indebted vnto the
pff, By specialty in the summe of Six hund^d & Eighty pownds of
Tob. & Cask & a Beauer Skin, (as appeareth in the s^d order) The
Adm̄istrato^e of the s^d Lewis, not pleading att all to the Contrary.
It is Ordered that the pff haue Judgm^t, agst the Adm̄istrato^e, accord-
ing to the former Order, & as is demanded.

Eltonhead v. Uppon the Petⁿ of M^{rs} Jane Elltonhead ffenwick pff, agst Henry
Pope Pope dēft; shewing th^t the dēft layeth Claime to the pffs marke,
wherewth she useth to marke her cattle, & also hath killed a Steere
belonging to the pff, as shee alleageth. Respited till next Court.

Ferriera v. The Crosse Accōns of Daudid Ferriera, & Docto^e Lumbrozo.
Lumbrozo Both accōns Respited till next Court.
The Court adiornd by the Gouverno^e till Afternoone.

Re Estate of M^r John Hatch Sayth uppon Oath, th^t M^r John Ashcombe did
Dandy acknowledge before this Dep^t, An Account, belonging to John
Dandy to bee due. But what the summe was he knoweth not.

Trueman v. Uppon the Petⁿ of Thomas Truman pff agst Will^m Stephenson
Stephenson dēft, the pff alleging that the dēft deteynes from him on thowsand
pownds of Tob, & 3 barrells Corne for the hyre of a Seruant &c:
This Cause as put to Arbitraōn & ended betwixt themselues.

Boreman v. Will^m Samford aged 20 yeares or thereabouts att the request of
Brookes Will^m Boreman Examined & deposed sayth. That about Two yeares
agoe, hee this Dept. then lyuing wth ffrancis Brooks, Heard the s^d
Brooks, say, That he had disposed of one hogshead of Tob, w^{ch} hee
affirmed hee did take away & dispose of wthout Edward Cloxstons
consent: Because (as hee alleaged) the s^d Claston, was indebted to
him the s^d Brooks, in the like, or a great quanty And further he
affirmeth th^t hee heard the s^d Brooks, confesse, or say the same wthin
this Two monthes, & further sayth not.

Uppon the Petⁿ of Will^m Boreman pff agst ffrancis Brooks dēft,
Shewing th^t the dēft came & tooke away one hogshead of Tob, out
of the howse of Edward Claxston, w^{ch} s^d Tob was made ou^e to the
pff for security of a Debt, due from the s^d Claxston Alleging further
that the Tob, soe taken away by the dēft, was struck by him the s^d pff
into a hogshead: & the hogshead also being marked by him the s^d
