By the Upper House of Assembly 4 July 1746

Gentlemen

We find You have Omitted in the Journal of Accounts to make an Allowance of part of the Chancellors fees, also part of the Secretarys fees

We also observe you have not made the several Allowances mentioned in the Message from this House on 1 June 1744 and 28 September 1745
