3<sup>dly</sup> That A Writ of Execution on a Judgment in the Secretarys fees be 45 instead of 41 it being an Error in the deduction in the Bill

4<sup>thly</sup> That there be added to the Examiner Generals fees the following Words viz in the same manner for every Tract on a Resurvey, for the Vacancy if any be added and for the whole when reduced into one Tract

5<sup>thly</sup> That the same Allowances as in the Secretarys Office for services not mentioned in the Act be in the several Other Offices

6<sup>thly</sup> That after the Words, Great Seal, in third Line of 22<sup>d</sup> Page insert the Words, or Surveyor General when such Office shall be in the hands of the Governor The Words, And Be it Enacted whenever any Attachment is laid where the Sheriff doth not take the Effects in his Custody that there he shall have no Condemnation fee
