We herewith return the two following Bills viz. a Bill Ent^d an
Act to divide Prince Georges County and to erect a new one by the
name of Frederick County and a Bill ent^d an Act to divide Dorches-
ter and Queen Anns Counties and to erect a new one out of the Upper
part thereof by the name of Prince William County and as We
cannot consistent with our Duty introduce a Precedent unknown in
the manner of passing our Laws within this Province so We cannot
agree to the Amendments proposed by your House But We are
sensible that the People greatly want and desire those Bills to take
place as Laws, We are willing to lengthen the time in them respec-
tively ment^d to the 29 day of Sept^r 1747 and hope Your Honours will
agree with us therein
