It appearing to this House, that ye have acted in an illegal and oppressive Manner, in refusing to take the Money due from Robert Haselop, of Charles County, for his Quit Rents, when he made a Tender thereof; and by distraining the Plow-Horse belonging to the said Haselop, and appraising him in a manner contrary to the prescribed form of the Act of Parliament in such Cases provided. And as such Oppressions are grievous to the people, I am Directed by the House to admonish you to take care how you run into the like Errors for the future, which I accordingly do; and acquaint you, That upon payment of the ffees to the several Officers, and Charges of Attendance of the Witnesses, taxed by this House, you will be discharged from the Custody of the Serjeant at Arms.
