On the Application of William Smith Esquire of Baltimore Town who is to this purpose Authorized and Commissioned by Robert Morris Esq^r of Philadelphia who is Agent for the supply of his Catholic Majesty's Fleets and armies in the Spanish Colonies in the West Indies, Licence is hereby given to lade and Export in the Brigantine Hawke, John Bull Commander and the Schooner Unity Commanded by Joseph Elliott now lying in the Port of Baltimore, flour for the use aforesaid on their Clearing out at the proper Office and Complying with the terms heretofore mentioned and directed to be complied with.
