That the Owners of the Brigg shall have one Half of the Proceeds of the Cargoe at the Port of Delivery, and the State the other Half. That the State shall be entitled to load one Half of the Brigg back Freight free. That the Owners of the Brigg transport the Flour to the Havana and pay all Port Charges here and at the Port of Delivery and the Charges of loading and unloading the Cargoe That the State shall be entitled to one Third of all Prize money which may p.8 be received by the Owners of the Brigg. That the Vessel be well armed Manned and found for the Voyage. If you accept of these Terms, it will be proper to proceed immediately in loading the Vessel, and that you inform us of your Determination.
