Warrant issued, directed to Donaldson Yates Esquire Dep<sup>y</sup> Q Master Gen<sup>l</sup> to impress what Carriages Teams and Drivers may be necessary for removing the Cannon Stores, Baggage &<sup>ca</sup> belonging to the Detachment under the Command of the Marquise De la Fayette across from Christiana to the Head of Elk and also all Vessels, hands &<sup>ca</sup> that are at Elk or else where which may be necessary.

Warrants issued, directed to John Bullen Esquire to impress all the Vessels with their hands &<sup>ca</sup> in the River severn, to proceed with
