The general Assembly finding it impracticable to complete the Quota of Men to be raised by this State within the Time required, have reduced the regiment extraordinary, recalled the field and commissioned officers and incorporated the Non Commissioned Officers Privates of that regiment with the old regiments, and we have agreeable to their requisition transmitted you a Copy of the Act for that Purpose.

## [Council to James Calhoun, Esqr.]

We shall be obliged to you to procure of M<sup>r</sup> Smith one hundred Barrels of Bread if he can Spare as much on the same Terms as that obtained from him some Time past, if he should not have that Quantity you will deliver over to M<sup>r</sup> Donellan Flour Sufficient with what he has in his possession to make up the Quantity (reserving enough for the Fort at Baltimore) which he is to have baked and barrelled immediately. What you may procure from M<sup>r</sup> Smith and may be made from the Flour in yours and M<sup>r</sup> Donellans Hands is to p. 94 be delivered over to M<sup>r</sup> Poe to be transported down the Bay for the use of the Detachment commanded by the Marquis Fayette.
