That the Armourer deliver to Col^o Elijah Robosson five pound of powder and twenty pounds of Shott or lead for the use of the Militia of Ann Arundel County and to be accounted for.

That Capt. Phileman Warfield deliver to Capt Deale two Chests of Arms N^o 6 & 7 containing sixty stand of Arms one hh^d N^o 2 containing fifty nine Cartridges Boxes and Bayonet Belts, also six hundred Muskett Cartridges and one hundred and twenty Flints to be delivered over to Col^o John Weems for the use of the Militia of Ann Arundel County.
