We have ordered the British Prisoners now under Guard in this City to be immediately sent to Fort Frederick into Confinement and have directed Col. Brice Lieutenant of Ann Arundel County to procure a Sufficient Number of Militia to guard them there on his Application, you'll be so obliging as to have them delivered.

That the said Treasurer pay to Martin Norris Twenty pounds, eight shillings and nine pence due him per Account passed by the Aud. Gen^l

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Linthecum fourteen pounds, three shillings and five pence due him per Account passed by the D. Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Campbell a Lame Soldier of the 3^d Regiment Twenty pounds on Account.
